

This is done through the use of the Liturgy, faith discussions guided by the

Canons of the Institute, various fun activities, and charity work throughout the year. Sursum Corda usually meets once a month. All are welcome to join us - whether single, married, or considering a religious vocation.





#### Thought from St. Francis de Sales:

The goodness of God is so great that often He gives a taste of the sweetness of His divinity to those souls who serve Him, offering numerous graces and favors that we must never forget. On our part we should remember the bitterness, the abuse and the sorrows that the glorious saint, Nicholas of

Tolentino, whom the Church commemorates today. After wholly renouncing the world and having crucified himself with Christ, at the hour of his death he asked that the wood of the holy cross be brought to him. Seeing it, he exclaimed, "O holy cross, so ardently desired ... I salute you, precious cross, upon which one may sail the sea of the world to arrive at the port of eternity." And in truth, to make sure of our eternal salvation, there in no better way than by means of the cross.
