And, moreover, **there is ever more good and consolation in the public offices of the Church than in what is done individually**, God having so ordained that what is done in common should be preferred to every kind of individual action.”

## EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING

It has been a tradition in the Catholic Church to bless chalk on the Eve of Epiphany, and then use the blessed chalk as part of blessing homes in the New Year.

The home blessing can be done as follows:

Use the blessed chalk to write above the doorways:

**20+C+M+B+24**

*2024 for the year; C, M, B for Christus Mansionem Benedicat, Latin for "May Christ bless this house" and the 3 Wise Men – Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar.*

As you are writing, pray one of the following prayers:

Lord God of heaven and earth, Thou hast revealed Thy only-begotten Son to every nation by the guidance of a star. Deign to bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our charity amongst ourselves and for others may reflect Thy love. Through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

Lord our God, deign to bless this household. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness, and the keeping of Thy holy law. We give thanks to Thee, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, Who livest and reignest world without end. Amen.

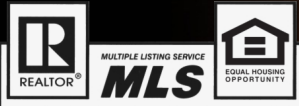

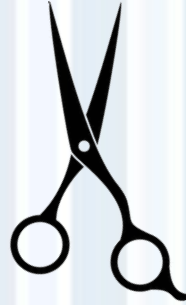

# ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY FAMILY

Recommended by Pope Leo XIII  
*Breve Nominem Fugit*

"**O Jesus**, our most loving Saviour! Thou Who wast sent down from Heaven to enlighten the world by Thy teaching and example, and Who didst will to pass the greater part of Thy holy life in Nazareth, subject to Mary and Joseph, and thereby didst hallow the household which was to be the pattern for all Christian families, do Thou in Thy goodness receive our household which this day consecrates itself to Thee. Protect and guard us, strengthen us in Thy holy fear, establish in our hearts the peace and concord of Christian Charity, so that each one of us becoming like to the Divine model of Thy family, may be sharers of eternal joy."

"**O Mary**, most loving Mother of Jesus Christ, our Mother, through thy love and mercy intercede, that Jesus receive this act of Consecration, and pour out upon us His graces and blessings."

"**O Joseph**, most holy Guardian of Jesus and Mary, help us by thy prayers in all our necessities, both of body and soul; that together with the Blessed Virgin Mary and thyself we shall praise and thank Jesus Christ, our Divine Redeemer."
