Epiphany Water and Blessing

The Epiphany Water will be blessed on the Vigil of the Epiphany. This holy water receives the same blessing as normal holy water, but there are other prayers, exorcisms and blessings in addition to the normal blessings which makes this a powerful sacramental. Do not forget that the Epiphany blessing for homes is done from January 6th-13th. Please ask if you would like your home blessed.
