

Epiphany Water

The Epiphany Water which was blessed on the Vigil of the Epiphany is located in the front of church in the large, metal holy water font. This holy water receives the same blessing as normal holy water, but there are other prayers, exorcisms and blessings in addition to the normal blessing which makes this a powerful sacramental.
