### The Joy of Children at Mass, Part 2

#### Dear Veterans of the Parish,

Your prayers have been answered and your persevering sacrifices are bearing fruit: the Parish is alive & well and growing with young families! Deo gratias!

With families come babies and children. They too must be welcomed into the parish, they too must be received with patience and joy. I ask that your disposition and demeanor remain charitable toward the families who make the extra effort to bring their young ones to Mass where they are raised in the practice of the Faith. An understanding and tolerance on your part of some light noises that are inevitable will be met by the parents' effort to keep the children supervised and behaved. Inconsolable babies will be brought to the Vestibule to calm down thus maintaining a respectful ambiance for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

## What are the prayers we say after Mass and why do we say them?

After a Low Mass the Celebrant leads the faithful in reciting the Leonine Prayers. They are called such after Pope St. Leo XIII, who after being granted a vision of Satan's plan to attack the Church from within and from without, asked these prayers to be said: Three Hail Mary's, the Hail Holy Queen, a prayer for the safeguard of Holy Mother Church, the St. Michael Prayer, and Three Invocations of the Sacred Heart.

## Are there not more prayers after every Mass that we say here at Sts. Cyril and Methodius?

Yes, at Sts. Cyril and Methodius more prayers are recited after every Mass, not just a Low Mass. This is because we are an Apostolate of the Institute of Christ the King. As such, we recite the Memorare (a favorite Prayer of St. Francis de Sales, Patron of the Institute). We recite this prayer in union with all of the Institute of Christ the King Apostolates across America for the Intention of our U.S. Superior.

We also recite a Prayer to St. Joseph composed by St. Francis de Sales. This prayer has been added to our daily devotions since the grave illness of Canon Altiere. Through the powerful intercession of St. Joseph we ask, if it be God's Will, that he grant our Pastor and Rector a full and speedy recovery of health.



## What are the Prayers that the Altar Boys say together before and after serving Mass?

#### **Server's Prayer BEFORE Mass:**

Jesus, here I am at the foot of Thy altar in order to offer to Thee the best moments of my day, together with my work, my joys, and sorrows.

I am a son of Thy sanctuary. Thou art my God, my beloved Savior. I give to Thee my heart. Grant me an angelic purity in order that I may be worthy to approach Thee.

Grant me the grace to assist at Mass with attention, piety, and recollection. Preserve me from all immature behavior, distractions, and negligence. I want to glorify Thy holy Church. I want to serve Thy priest as I would serve Thee Thyself. May my conduct be edifying for the faithful who are present.

O Virgin Mary, the Lady of altar servers, pray to God for me. My good angel, I entrust myself to thy protection. Amen.

#### Server's Prayer AFTER Mass:

Most beloved Jesus, I thank Thee for the privilege of serving at Thy altar. I am very grateful for the gift of Holy Communion and for the joy of serving in Thy sanctuary! Grant me the grace to never forget Thy blessings. Help me to serve Thee in all that I do. May my thoughts, words, and actions always be pleasing to Thee. Amen.
