Solemn First Vespers of the Epiphany at 5:30 p.m., followed by the blessing of Epiphany water If you cannot come to the blessing, you can drop off your prefilled water container (one per family) after the morning Mass. For practical reasons, the bottle MUST have an easily removable cap that is sufficiently large (no smaller than a standard milk jug-sized opening); containers with narrow necks will NOT have exorcized salt added to them.
