Dear faithful,

It is holy simplicity, daughter and inseparable companion of humility, that will show us how, two things coexist, and mutually tell on each other: the close, deliberate consideration of the favors she has received from heaven, and the clear consciousness of her own miseries. This admirable simplicity will lead us to the school of the Scriptures and of the saints, there to teach us that the soul's being praised in the Lord, and our glorying in the Lord, is really a giving praise and glory to God Himself. When St. Paul, after having expressed the low estimation he had of himself compared with the other apostles, adds that grace had not been a failure in him, and that he had even labored more abundantly than all of them, it was by the conviction and the desire that God must not, and shall not, be disappointed in His gifts, either by the self-appropriation of pride, or by the silence of ingratitude.
