

UPDATE ON OUR CURRENT CHURCH PROJECTS

Our team is currently working with McKenzie Construction LLC, (General Contractor) on the following projects:

- •Gutter & Downspout Repairs (inspection and repairs in the next weeks)
- •Stained Glass Windows currently in the shop: 90% done, and will be reinstalled in the Spring.
- Façades Restoration: RAM to finish punch list and close contract in March.
- •WJE Engineering currently working on addressing steeple issues revealed during restoration and cleaning. Work expected to start in the summer.
- •Roof repairs: assessments and project scope currently in progress.
- •HVAC improvements: Studies are ready. Electrician to start next month a more thorough investigation for potential contract.

MASS INTENTIONS AT THE SHRINE OFFERING MASS FOR A LOVED ONE

As we begin the new year, we would like to continue to offer masses for your loved ones, your private intentions of a deceased faithful. Our Mass calendar is open. The value of one single mass is infinite, let us draw profusely from this source of infinite graces for ourselves and the ones we love. <u>Please consider the following options:</u>

- 1. You can request a public mass (intention will be entered in the bulletin) for any of your intentions, for the living or the dead.
- 2. You can have the mass celebrated privately by one of our canons, as each priest has to say his Mass every day. When one doesn't have to celebrate the public mass, he celebrates what is called a "private Mass".
- 3. You can also enroll your intention(s) in our St. Joseph Confraternity. For a \$50 donation per enrollee, they will have 52 Masses a year celebrated for them and all our other Confraternity enrollees. Confraternity Masses are celebrated every Wednesday at Noon followed by the St Joseph Perpetual Novena prayers, from 3/19/24 to 3/19/25.

Mass cards and envelopes are available in the Church vestibule or in the office during office hours (see below).
