### IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER AND OF THE SON AND OF THE HOLY GHOST

Sometimes we speak of the Trinity as a mystery."

Mystery doesn't mean something impossible.

It doesn't mean something illogical, or even unknowable.

It simply means that we would not have known that there is a Trinity if God had chosen not to tell us.

And that points us to understand what we do when we make the Sign of the Cross: We are announcing our intention and the authority for our prayers; and we are professing our Faith. But, perhaps, most important of all, when we make the Sign of the Cross, we are acknowledging God's love for us that He loves His creatures enough to tell us about His Trinity, which we could never know on our own – that He loves us so much that He takes us into His own private life, introducing us to the members of God's own family – and even allows us to participate in Their life through prayer, the Mass, and the Sacraments.

And hopefully – whenever we make the Sign of the Cross, we are telling God that we love Him in return – that we love Him in Unity; and that we love Him in Trinity; The Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.

## A century ago, on Trinity Sunday

At that time a young, 22 year-old girl, suffering from tuberculosis, wrote a letter to the Trinity. She offered herself as a Victim of Holocaust to God's Merciful Love.

“O My God! Most Blessed Trinity, I desire to Love You and make You Loved, to work for the glory of Holy Church by saving souls on earth and liberating those suffering in purgatory. I desire to accomplish Your will perfectly and to reach the degree of glory You have prepared for me in Your Kingdom. I desire, in a word, to be a saint, but I feel my helplessness and I beg You, O my God! to be Yourself my Sanctity!”

“In the evening of this life, I shall appear before You with empty hands, for I do not ask You, Lord, to count my works. All our justice is stained in Your eyes. I wish, then, to be clothed in Your own Justice and to receive from Your Love the eternal possession of Yourself. I want no other Throne, no other Crown but You, my Beloved!”



“I want, O my Beloved, at each beat of my heart to renew this offering to You an infinite number of times, until the shadows having disappeared I may be able to tell You of my Love in an Eternal Face to Face!”

**She signed this prayer:** Marie, Françoise, Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face, unworthy Carmelite religious.

Month of the Sacred Heart

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: “My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition.” She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it “the great act” of his pontificate.
