# **But Only Say the Word**

We should have compassion on all those with whom we are dealing. Even those whom we might consider enemies should be treated with respect—indeed with mercy.

The idea of taking revenge on someone who has harmed us should not enter our minds.



We should recognize that an evildoer who causes us to hate him has conquered us—that by eliciting our hatred he has harmed us more than he did by the original hurt. If we wish to gain satisfaction for this hurt we are to feed our enemy's hunger, and slake his thirst.

Today's Mass teaches us a lesson about the importance of faith for eternal salvation. Our Lord commends the centurion for the strength of his faith:

I have not found such great faith in Israel. And I say to you that many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven; but the children of the kingdom shall be cast into the exterior darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

Clearly, our Lord was referring to those of the chosen people that would reject Him and ultimately have Him put to death. But Catholics should never be so complacent as to think that He was referring to the Jews alone. The children of the Church are God's new chosen people. We have received the immeasurable gifts of God's revelation, and through Baptism, the means to sanctifying grace.

We must follow the centurion's good example, acknowledging the omnipotence of God, and trusting in His compassion, lest we too "be cast into the exterior darkness, with the weeping and gnashing of teeth." Let us not waste our time!

# **Chair of Unity Octave**

# Oration for the removal of schism January 18 - January 25

From January 18 (Feast of the Chair of St. Peter in Rome) to January 25 (the Conversion of St. Paul) are the Octave of Prayers for the Unity of the Church. This prayer is said once-a-day during this Octave.

Ant. That they all may be one, as Thou, Father, in me and I in Thee, that they also may be one in us; that the world may believe that Thou hast sent me.

V. I say to thee, that thou art Peter,

R. And upon this rock I will build my Church.

#### Let us pray:

Lord Jesus Christ, Who didst say to thine Apostles: peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you, look not upon my sins, but upon the faith of Thy Church; and vouchsafe unto her that peace and unity which is agreeable to Thy will: Who livest and reignest God forever and ever. Amen.

#### **Intentions of the Octave**

January 18th: The union of all Christians in the one true Faith and in the Church;

January 19th: The return of separated Eastern Christians to communion with the Holy See;

January 20th: The reconciliation of Anglicans with the Holy See;

January 21st: The reconciliation of European Protestants with the Holy See;

January 22nd: That American Christians become one in union with the Chair of Peter; January 23rd: The restoration of lapsed Catholics to the sacramental life of the Church; January 24th: That the Jewish people come into their inheritance in Jesus Christ; January 25th: The missionary extension of Christ's kingdom throughout the world.

#### St. John Chrysostom

Friday, January 27 - 6:00 p.m. Mass

St. John Chrysostom (347-407 A.D.) was born to noble parents in Antioch, an important center of Christianity in his day. After the death of his father, his mother sent him to the best schools for his education. As a result of his philosophical studies he was convinced of the truth of Christianity, entered the Church, and became a renowned scholar and orator. He then adopted a life of extreme asceticism as a hermit and committed the whole of Sacred Scripture to memory. The brilliance of his mind combined with the holiness of his soul made him famous; he was ordained a bishop in Antioch and was later appointed to the Archbishopric of Constantinople. He was an incredible preacher, among the greatest in the history of the Church, which earned him the name 'Chrysostom' meaning, 'Golden-mouthed' or 'Golden tongued'. His sermons, which extended for up to two hours, were public marvels. His straightforward style of preaching the Scriptures and his practical homilies made him very popular. He also denounced the abuses of the ruling authority and preached against the immorality of the day, which resulted in him being exiled numerous times. He was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 451. His feast day in the (1962) liturgical calendar is celebrated on January 27.
