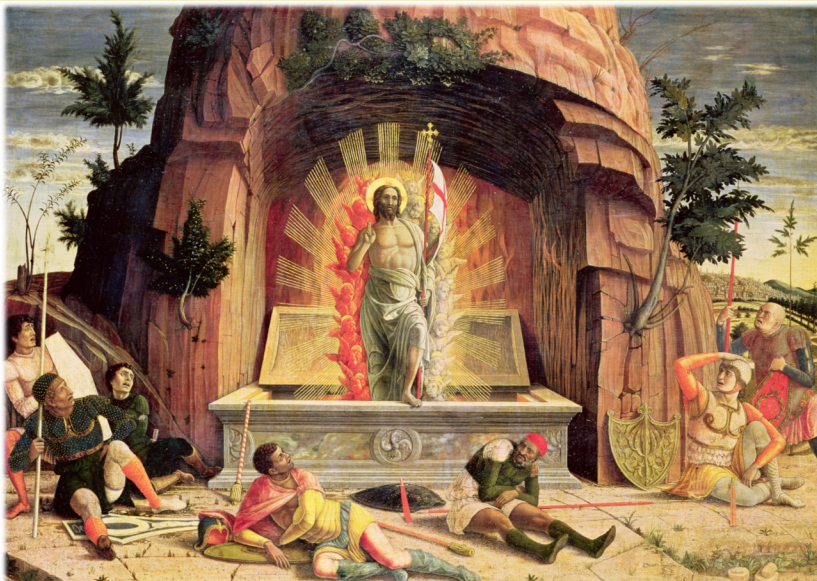

THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST

Christ our Pasch is immolated, alleluia; Let us feast with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth!



Paschal Time is the most sacred segment of the liturgical year. Easter is the feast of feasts, the solemnity of solemnities, as it is on this day that the mission of the Word Incarnate attains the triumphant goal – man is raised up from his fall and regains what he had lost by Adam’s sin.

The Resurrection of Christ is the best proof of His divinity, the strongest seal of His doctrines, and the keystone of our redemption and pledge of bodily resurrection. ***Salvation comes not from the cross alone but through Christ’s resurrection***, and God regains creation, as it was from the beginning. This anniversary is the holiest of days since it opens to us the gate of Heaven into which we shall enter because we have risen together with Christ – the Church had us come well prepared through bodily mortification and compunction of heart, unless we were lax and indifferent to the season of penitence.

Eastertide contains three manifestations of divine love and power – the Resurrection, the Ascension, and Pentecost. The first week of Easter is traditionally a time of great joy – fasts are discontinued. Jesus will be with us for another 40 days. But the joy continues right through the 50 days of the season until Pentecost. Christ, upon His Ascension will not leave us orphans because He promised us the Holy Ghost.

Sequence for Easter Sunday: Victimae Paschali Laudes

Forth to the paschal Victim, Christians, Bring your sacrifice of praise: The Lamb redeems the sheep; And Christ the sinless One, Hath to the Father sinners reconciled. Together, death and life In a strange conflict strove. The Prince of life, who died, Now lives and reigns. What thou sawest Mary, say, As thou wentest on the way. I saw the tomb wherein the living one had lain; I saw His glory as He rose again; Napkin and linen clothes, and angels twain: Yea Christ is risen, my hope, and He will go before you into Galilee. We know that Christ indeed has risen from the grave: Hail, Thou King of Victory, Have mercy, Lord, and save. Amen. Alleluia.

THE REGINA CAELI

The *Regina Caeli* replaces the *Angelus* from Easter to the Octave of Pentecost.
 It is recited at 6 a.m., Noon, and 6 p.m. each day.

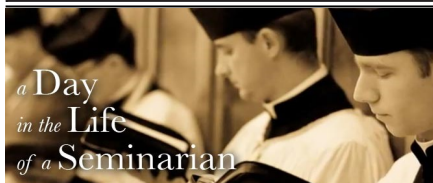


SCHOOL LUNCH FOR AFRICA ENDS TODAY EASTER SUNDAY
