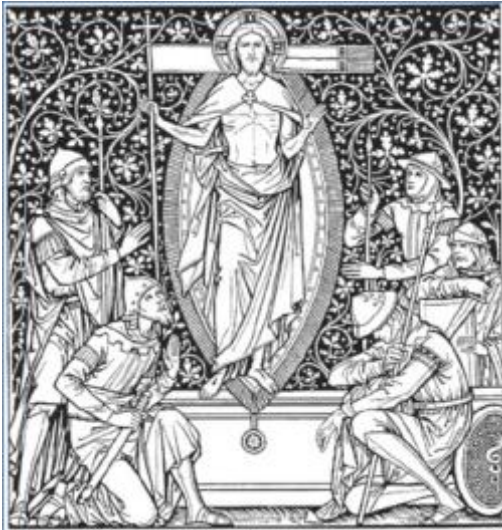

By Church law, in order to be a practicing Catholic, it is necessary to confess one's grave sins at least once a year (canon 989) and to receive holy communion at least once a year, during the Easter season (canon 920), counted between the First Sunday of Lent and Trinity Sunday.
