## Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call “Children’s Catechism” and “Teenage Catechism” are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) **Classes are held on church grounds.**

**Children’s Catechism** = Those the age of preparing for 1st Communion to 12 yrs old.  
**2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

**Teenage Catechism** = 13-19 yrs old.  
**1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

Sacramental Catechism is for those getting ready to receive the designated Sacrament. Classes will occur on scheduled and posted Saturdays of the year after 8am Mass.

**1st Communion Catechism** = starting at age 6, *classes begin in November*

**Confirmation Catechism** = starting at age 10/11, *classes begin in January*

This includes preparation in the sacristy, serving on the Altar, playing the organ, and singing for the Liturgies.

The spiritual life of our Oblates is directed toward a spirit of service and charity, following the example of the Holy Family which had at its center Our Lord, Incarnate Priest and King. Consequently, Oblates see their lives as a charitable service rendered to the Priesthood of the Lord, in the Church and in our Institute.
