### Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call "Children's Catechism" and "Teenage Catechism" are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) Classes are held on church grounds.

**Children's Catechism** = 6-12 yrs old. **2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

**Teenage Catechism** = 13-19 yrs old. **1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

**1st Communion Catechism** = starting at age 6, *classes began in November, on designated Saturdays*

**Confirmation Catechism** = starting at age 10/11, *classes begin in January, on designated Saturdays*
