Frequently Asked Questions?

Q. What are the extra prayers said at Mass after the Collect of the Day?

A. After the Collect, Secret, and Post-communion the commemoration ***Pro Papa*** is prayed. Ever since the Institute of Christ the King was raised to Pontifical Right some 15 years ago, all the Canons of the Institute say this extra Collect for the Pope at every Mass that's not a 1st Class feast day (when there are no additional Collects). Most missals for the faithful have these ***Pro Papa*** prayers in the section of special Collects.

Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call "Children's Catechism" and "Teenage Catechism" are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) Classes are held on church grounds.

Children's Catechism = 6-12 yrs old. **2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

Teenage Catechism = 13-19 yrs old. **1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

1st Communion Catechism = starting at age 6, *classes began in November, on designated Saturdays*

Confirmation Catechism = starting at age 10/11, *classes begin in January, on designated Saturdays*
