A Word from the Rector, Canon Stein

While still within the joys of the Christmas season our gaze quickly turns toward the Cross. Yes, the beloved Cross for which Christ was born. He was born *to die*, to die *for us*.

The Liturgical Calendar helps us in this quick transition. Next Sunday is already Septuagesima Sunday, the three week period of preparation for Lent.

For this reason our Christmas Cleanup will be next Saturday, January 27th after 8am Mass.

Next Saturday will also be the joyous occasion of baptism for two siblings. *Please allow the Sacramental Ceremony of Baptism to occur first before taking down the decorations in the Nave.*

Cleanup should start outside and in the Sanctuary with the three trees.

The Manger Scene can and will stay up until February 2nd. *The Creche is not part of the January 27th cleanup.*

Remember, Mangers get put away by February 2nd when Our Lord is presented in the Temple.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What are the devotions we pray each month from the 17th to the 25th?

A. The devotions prayed each month from the 17th to the 25th are prayers to the Infant King. It is a monthly novena to the Christ Child in response to His promise “The more you honor Me, the more I will bless you.”

This Novena is also done in union with the Institute of Christ the King’s National Headquarters in Chicago where we have a Shrine to Christ the King and our historic Christ Child statue miraculously preserved from fire.

Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call “Children’s Catechism” and “Teenage Catechism” are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) Classes are held on church grounds.

Children’s Catechism = 6-12 yrs old. **2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

Teenage Catechism = 13-19 yrs old. **1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

1st Communion Catechism = starting at age 6, *classes began in November, on designated Saturdays*

Confirmation Catechism = starting at age 10/11, *classes began in January, on designated Saturdays*
