Lenten Resolutions and Reform for Old St. Patrick Oratory

Dear Faithful of the Oratory, Allow me to communicate paternally clear standards and rules for the good order of the church:

Reclaiming the Sacristy: *The Sacristy is a sacred place dedicated to the preparation of the Liturgy and the housing of sacred vessels/ vestments.*

- The Sacristy is exclusively reserved for the Clergy and Altar Servers.
- All Office Work (with the exception of collection counting *outside of the Liturgy*) now takes place at 2123 Erie St.

Reclaiming the Sanctuary: *The Sanctuary is the Holy of Holies and is reserved for the Liturgy and the Church's ministers and servers.*

- No lay volunteer entry in the Sanctuary immediately before or after Liturgies.
- No flower watering by volunteers while the Clergy are still saying their prayers of Thanksgiving.

We thank our generous volunteers for all they do for the good of the Oratory. The implementation of these good habits and standards will maintain the sense of the sacred and the atmosphere of prayer.

Lenten Resolutions & Reform, continued

Reclaiming the Narthex: *The Narthex (vestibule) is an area within the House of God and must be treated as such.*

- Only parents tending to their children, & assigned Ushers may be in the Narthex during the Liturgy.
- The Narthex is not a play area. It is where one calms a child to return to the pew.
- The Narthex is not a Parlor for parents.

Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call “Children’s Catechism” and “Teenage Catechism” are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) Classes are held on church grounds.

Children’s Catechism = 6-12 yrs old. **2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

Teenage Catechism = 13-19 yrs old. **1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

1st Communion Catechism = starting at age 6, *classes began in November, on designated Saturdays*

Confirmation Catechism = starting at age 10/11, *classes began in January, on designated Saturdays*
