Dear Faithful, March is full of feast days AND this March contains all of Holy Week concluding with Easter Day. I strongly encourage you to take off of work where possible for the Sacred Triduum. **We live in a secularized society; do not allow them to dictate the terms of your practice of the Faith.**

7:45am Low Mass, 6pm Solemn High Mass and Outdoor Procession with his relic

6pm Solemn High Mass

7:45am Low Mass, 6pm Solemn High Mass

**Wednesday, March 27 at 4:30pm:** Practice for the Easter Vigil

## Catechism 2023-2024

The new schedule for the different classes of catechism is here! What we call “Children’s Catechism” and “Teenage Catechism” are continual formation classes. They will occur on alternating Tuesdays at 4:30pm. (Note: if ever there is a 5th Tuesday, there is NO Catechism.) Classes are held on church grounds.

**Children’s Catechism** = 6-12 yrs old. **2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month**

**Teenage Catechism** = 13-19 yrs old. **1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month**

**1st Communion Catechism** = starting at age 6, *classes began in November, on designated Saturdays*

**Confirmation Catechism** = starting at age 10/11, *classes began in January, on designated Saturdays*
