SUNDAY, JUNE 19, 2022 EXTERNAL SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Dear faithful,

We celebrate this Sunday the External Solemnity of the beautiful feast of Corpus Christi, known by the delightfully simple term "La Fête Dieu" by French Catholics (the "Feast of God"). There will be the traditional Eucharistic Procession and devotions after the 12:30 Mass. Perhaps nothing so strikingly illustrates God's absolute dominion over all things as the miracle of Transubstantiation. This term from Scholastic Theology designates the act by which, through the instrumentality of His priests in the Holy Mass, Our Lord works the total change of the substance of bread and wine into the substance of His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. Let us examine our consciences regularly and have the humility, when necessary, to first have recourse to the Sacrament of Penance in preparation for Holy Communion.

The Institute of Christ the King assiduously trains its members in the Church's ancient liturgical arts, especially Sacred Music and in a preeminent way Gregorian Chant.
