SUNDAY, JUNE 26, 2022 EXTERNAL SOLEMNITY OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

We celebrate this Sunday the **External Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**. Pope Pius XII speaks eloquently of the heartfelt love of God for fallen men in his 1956 encyclical, *Haurietas Aquas*:

"...the Heart of Jesus Christ, hypostatically united to the divine Person of the Word, certainly beat with love and with the other emotions - but these, joined to a human will full of divine charity and to the infinite love itself which the Son shares with the Father and the Holy Spirit, were in such complete unity and agreement that never among these three loves was there any contradiction of or disharmony."

The <u>Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus</u> will be recited after both Masses this Sunday. We will also take up our annual collection for the Sisters Adorers on this day. Thank you for your generosity towards these sisters who pray for you always!

Bishop Barber has released a statement in support of and in gratitude for Friday's Supreme Court ruling striking down *Roe v. Wade*. In part, it reads:

Abortion causes pain, regret and a lifetime of psychological and spiritual harm to women and the fathers of their children."
