SUNDAY, JULY 10, 2022 FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST (Mass Propers available in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

Our Lord makes it clear in the Gospel of the Mass for this Fifth Sunday after Pentecost: there is no place for hatred or cursing of our brethren, nor even our enemies. Charity towards all and desire of each one's eternal salvation is absolutely necessary for us, even if from time to time some fraternal correction has to be administered to those who err from the straight and narrow way. Let us examine briefly the most striking words of Christ today:

"But I say to you, that whosoever is angry with his brother, shall be in danger of the judgment; and whosoever shall say to his brother: Raca, shall be in danger of the council; and whosoever shall say: Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire" (Matt. 5;20-24).


Let us strive always to make amends and be reconciled with those from whom disagreement and discord have separated us. Towards those who attack us or our Faith because of its supposed restrictions on the liberties of others, let us not return the insults and the vitriol. Let us extend rather the warm invitation to faith in Christ the Lord and in the only Church He founded, the Holy Catholic Church.

Those who take up the invitation will see that the only true liberty is when we are no longer burdened by anything that could separate us from God's Holy Will and the gifts He gives us, life being chief among them. As Our Lord Himself affirmed: "I am the way, and the truth, and the life" (John 14;6).

As previously mentioned, I will be going out of town this week to visit one of my fellow canons in the Institute. I will leave this Sunday after celebrating the 12:30 Mass, and <u>I will be back for both Sunday Masses next weekend</u>. Thank you for your prayers during this short vacation.
