SUNDAY, AUGUST 14, 2022 TENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST (Mass Propers available in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

On this Tenth Sunday after Pentecost, Holy Mother Church's insistence on the primordial role of humility in our relationship with God continues in Our Lord's parable of the Pharisee and the publican. The Pharisee's prayer, puffed up with pride as he recounts before God all his supposed accomplishments and virtues, contrasts strikingly with the prayer and demeanor of the publican, who will not even dare to look up to heaven on account of his sense of guilt for his sins.

As Our Lord tells us, it is indeed the publican who goes away justified. His prayer is not only humble, but also contrite. He strikes his breast in pained remembrance of a heart that once chose created goods as more precious than man's Supreme Good – God alone. His prayer is also full of confidence. His simple words, "O God, be merciful to me a sinner" shows his earnestness, it is clear that he believes these words of the Psalmist: "God will not despise a contrite and humble heart" (Ps. 50;19).
