Dear faithful,

"Holiness consists simply in doing God's will, and being just what God wants us to be." So informs us the great saint we honor this Sunday, **St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus, or St. Thérèse of Lisieux**. The greatest saint of the modern era, according to Pope Saint Pius X, did not sail the high seas through storms and land on lost islands, converting multitudes of the heathen. She was not the foundress of Catholic institutions of higher learning, or a new religious order. She did not retire to solitude in the burning heat of the desert and live a life of asceticism that would stretch her physical limits to capacity. She did not shed her martyr's blood in witness to the True Faith.
