#### Dear faithful,

There is rather a lot to announce this Sunday, so please get out your calendars and pencils! Or more likely, your mobile phones...

On Saturday, October 22, we began our <u>Infant King Novena</u>, which will culminate next Sunday, October 30, the Feast of Christ the King. The Institute of Christ the King invites you to join in this nationwide prayer campaign to <u>increase faith, hope, and grati-tude to our Infant King</u>.

During this novena of gratitude to the Christ Child, you can give glory to God daily by praying the Novena Prayer to our Infant King. Let us be generous each day in giving our time and effort as a sacrifice to Christ our Infant King!

For the <u>Feast of Christ the King next Sunday</u>, a plenary indulgence will once again be available, under the usual conditions, for this first class feast. The 12:30 Mass will be followed by a <u>Eucharistic Procession and Benediction</u> of the Blessed Sacrament. Exceptionally, there will not be a reception after the Mass because of the length of the ceremonies.

As is the custom, we will also take up our annual <u>special collection</u> <u>for the Institute's Seminary</u> next Sunday.

There will be a <u>rehearsal for the Confirmations on Thursday</u>, <u>November 3 at 6 pm</u> for confirmands, parents and sponsors. Confessions will be made available afterwards.

The <u>month of November</u> is almost upon us, and with that comes an increase in our prayers for the <u>Poor Souls in Purgatory</u>. I hope we will be able to <u>visit a local cemetery</u> on one of the first eight days of the month in order to pray for them, as is the tradition. The <u>tentative date is Thursday, November 3 after the 12 pm Mass</u>, though this may have to be modified. It is a little more delicate this year because the Confirmations are also taking place in this time frame. <u>Please be on the lookout</u> for more information.

In the coming month, let us remember in our prayers in particular **Diane Kasdan (RIP)**, a longtime member of our Oakland Apostolate family. Diane **passed from this world this past Monday**, October 17, the Feast of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, our apostolate's heavenly patroness. She had been fortified with the sacraments on more than one occasion in the months leading up to her death.

Though we were unfortunately not able to have our regular <u>Sursum</u> <u>Corda young adult group</u> meeting this month, the next meeting will be on <u>Thursday, November 17 here at St. Margaret Mary's</u>, beginning with the <u>Rosary at 6 pm</u>, followed by a talk, social dinner and the chanted Office of Compline to conclude the evening.
