Dear faithful,

King of Kings and Lord or Lords; this is the banner under which we flock to Christ our Lord today. Pope Pius XI reminds that it is not only in metaphorical terms that we speak of Christ the King; He is a king in the strict and proper sense of the word, and His Kingship is the model and source of all earthly kingdoms:

"For it is only as man that he may be said to have received from the Father 'power and glory and a kingdom,' since the Word of God, as consubstantial with the Father, has all things in common with him, and therefore has necessarily supreme and absolute dominion over all things created" (*Quas Primas*, December 11, 1925).

How comforting and enlivening it should be for our faith to know that Our Lord holds all things in subjection to His dominion, and that He is all-powerful to grant our requests and bring good from all things, even our mistakes! May this thought motivate us to serve Him with an ever greater confidence, truly in the spirit of being His loyal subjects.

The 12:30 Mass this Sunday will be followed by a <u>Eucharistic Procession and Benediction</u> of the Blessed Sacrament. We will recite the <u>Infant King Novena Prayer</u> and the <u>Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus</u>, in keeping with the tradition. Please find copies available in church. There will not be a reception after the Mass today; it will resume however next Sunday. A <u>plenary indulgence</u> will be available, under the usual conditions, on the occasion of this great feast

We will take up our annual <u>special collection for the Institute's Seminary</u> this Sunday. Thank you for your generosity! Your gifts are the means used by Providence to send us priests for tomorrow.

The <u>month of November</u> is almost upon us; traditionally consecrated to the <u>Holy Souls in Purgatory</u>. I will visit <u>St. Mary's Cemetery in Oakland</u> (4529 Howe St.) to pray for the faithful departed on <u>Tuesday, November 8 at 12 pm</u>; all are invited to join me who wish to do so. As you know, a <u>plenary indulgence</u> may be gained for the <u>Holy Souls</u> by praying for them in a <u>cemetery on any day from November 1 – 8</u>. The <u>list of conditions</u> for the November indulgences is attached in Flocknote, and copies are available in church.

There is the <u>Feast of All Saints this Tuesday</u>, <u>November 1</u> and <u>All Souls' Day on Wednesday</u>, <u>November 2</u>. Please be sure to check the <u>special Mass schedule</u> for these days, as there will be extra Masses. <u>November 1st is a Holy Day of Obligation</u>.

His Excellency, <u>Bishop of Oakland Michael Barber</u> will come to St. Margaret Mary's this coming <u>Saturday</u>, <u>November 5 at 3 pm</u> to administer the <u>Sacrament of Confirmation</u> to twenty-three of our young faithful. We thank Bishop Barber for generously visiting us and conferring the sacrament. Please keep these confirmands in your prayers, that they would become perfect soldiers of Christ.

There will be a <u>rehearsal for the Confirmations on Thursday, November 3 at 6 pm</u> for confirmands, parents and sponsors. Please <u>make sure to attend this rehearsal</u> if you will be involved in the Confirmations. <u>Confessions will be heard afterwards.</u>
