SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 27, 2022 FIRST SUNDAY IN ADVENT

Dear faithful.

On this First Sunday of Advent, Saint Paul shakes us from our spiritual slumber in a rather austere tone:

"Brethren, knowing that it is now the hour for us to rise from sleep. For now our salvation is nearer than when we believed. The night is passed and the day is at hand. Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day: not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and impurities, not in contention and envy: but put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ" (Epistle (Romans 13:11 – 14).

In this brief exhortation, we have before us the penitential nature of the Advent season laid out. Advent is certainly one of the most charming seasons of the year, filled with the joyful hope of the birth of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, as the tiny infant in the manger. If we wish to prepare a worthy welcome for Him in our hearts, let us begin from this moment to mortify ourselves and our sinful passions.

I hope you've been practicing the *Tota Pulchra Es*! It would be wonderful if everyone could join in the chant of this lovely Marian hymn.

There will be a **Requiem Mass for Mary Persinger**, sister of Mary and Maria de Ornellas, **this Wednesday**, **November 30 at 12 pm**, followed by the **funeral at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery** in Hayward (26320 Mission Blvd). Her **Rosary Vigil** will be **this Tuesday**, **November 29** at the Santos-Robinson Mortuary in San Leandro (160 Estudillo Ave.) at 6:30 pm.
