Dear faithful,

Saint Paul exhorts us in a special way to fraternal charity this Sunday with these words: "Wherefore receive one another, as Christ also hath received you unto the honor of God." Christ has allowed us to come to him, first when our parents brought us to the church on the day of our baptism. He received us as his brethren, adopted sons of His Eternal Father and co -heirs with Him in glory. He has received us time and again when we have gone astray and betrayed Him by our sins and our ingratitude for His many gifts. If He has received us so many times and indeed Has promised that He will never refuse us entry into His Sacred Heart, provided our repentance is sincere, does it not behoove us to try to be patient and for-giving towards our errant neighbor?

Our <u>Solemn Novena</u> in preparation for the Feast of the <u>Immaculate Conception of the</u> <u>Blessed Virgin Mary</u> continues this Sunday. We will recite the daily <u>Novena Prayer after 7</u> <u>am Mass</u>, and the <u>Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament</u> with hymns will take place <u>after</u> <u>the 12:30 Mass</u>. I hope you've been practicing the <u>Tota Pulchra!</u>

The Feast of the <u>Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary</u> is this <u>Thursday</u>, <u>December 8</u>, and it is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be <u>two Masses</u> that day, a <u>Low</u> <u>Mass followed by Exposition</u> of the Blessed Sacrament at <u>12 pm</u>, and a <u>High Mass followed by Exposition</u> of the Blessed Sacrament at <u>6 pm</u>. In keeping with the tradition, we will renew the Consecration of our institute and all its members and faithful to the Immaculate Conception.

Christmas cards will once again be sold in the <u>vestibule this Sunday</u>, December 4 after the 7 am Mass, and in Kozina Hall after the 12:30 Mass. Christmas cards for the seminarians will also be collected by Diana Henriksson and several volunteers. There has been a slight change for those planning to sign <u>Christmas cards for seminarians after the 12:30</u> Mass. These cards will be available in the <u>vestibule</u> after the Mass. Please take one, sign and <u>return it next Sunday</u>, December 11. There will be a basket in the vestibule to deposit the signed cards.

St. Margaret Mary Church invites all the faithful to a used **book sale** in Kozina Hall. The sale will begin on **Saturday, December 10 from 6-8 pm**, and continue on **Gaudete Sunday, December 11**, from 8am - 3pm. Most items will be priced at \$2 or less.
