SUNDAY, DECEMBER 25, 2022 NATIVITY OF OUR LORD

Dear faithful,

The Feast of Christmas has finally arrived! After four weeks of penance, we welcome the joy of seeing Our Infant King born to us. Dom Prosper Guéranger reminds us of the true reason for the joy of this season:

"...the great mystery of the twenty-fifth of December, being the Feast of our Saviour's Birth, has reference, not to the division of time marked out by God himself, which is called the Week; but to the course of that great Luminary which gives life to the world, because it gives it light and warmth. Jesus, our Saviour, the Light of the World (John 8;12), was born when the night of idolatry and crime was at its darkest; and the day of his Birth, the twenty-fifth of December, is that on which the material Sun begins to gain his ascendency over the reign of gloomy night, and show to the world his triumph of brightness" (*The Liturgical Year*).

It's no secret that Christmas can be a difficult time of year for many of us and for various reasons. Perhaps we feel in our hearts a little bit of that darkness that pervaded the world at the time Our Blessed Lord was born. And unlike so many whose lives preceded the Incarnation of Christ, we know what the hope is which sustains us — a blessed eternity with God, Our Creator and the greatest Friend of our souls
