The <u>Veni Creator</u> will be chanted this Sunday before both Masses to implore God's graces for the new year. A <u>plenary indulgence</u> is available under the usual conditions for being present for the chanting of this hymn and the Mass which follows.

The **blessing of Epiphany Water and Salt** will take place this Thursday, January 5 after the 12 pm Mass.

Friday, January 6 is the Feast of the <u>Epiphany of Our Lord</u>, a First Class Feast and one of the most ancient and solemn feasts of the entire liturgical year. There will be of course the traditional blessings of gold, frankincense, myrrh and chalk. The **External Solemnity** of the Epiphany will be celebrated on Sunday, January 8.

Did you know? The Epiphany Chalking of the Doors:

The Epiphany "chalking of the doors" blessing can be done either by a priest or the father of the family. Using blessed chalk, the following is written above the entrance of the home:

$$20 + C + M + B + 23$$

The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Malchior, and Balthazar — who came to visit Our Lord in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, "Christus mansionem benedicat": "May Christ bless this home." The "+" signs represent the cross, and the "20" at the beginning and the "23" at the end mark the current year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a request for Christ to bless those homes so marked and that He stay with those who dwell therein throughout the entire year.

Most often the chalking takes place after Epiphany Mass, and can be done at any church, home, or dwelling. This blessing can be performed simply by just writing the inscription and offering a short prayer, or more elaborately, including songs, prayers, processions, the burning of incense, and the sprinkling of holy water.
