SUNDAY, JANUARY 8, 2023 EXT. SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY (Mass Propers available in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

We celebrate today the External Solemnity of the Epiphany of Our Lord, one of the oldest and most important feasts of the entire liturgical year. This feast is somewhat unique in that it commemorates three different events in the life of Our Lord – the Adoration of the Magi, Our Lord's baptism, and His first miracle; the changing of water into wine at the wedding feast of Cana.

Dom Prosper Guéranger teaches us in *The Liturgical Year* that there is yet another symbolism of this great feast – the bringing of all nations into the One, True Church. He writes that the voyage of the Three Magi towards Bethlehem symbolizes the movement of all nations towards the true Jerusalem:

"Jerusalem is not large enough to hold all this sea of nations; another city must be founded, and towards her shall be turned the countless Gentiles of Madian and Epha. Thou, O Rome, art this Holy City, and thy heart shall wonder and be enlarged. Heretofore thy victories have won thee slaves; but from this day forward, thou shalt draw within thy walls countless children."

Our regular <u>Sunday reception</u> resumes today, complete with a traditional and sumptuous <u>King's Cake!</u> Several of our generous faithful will bring King's Cake from various regional traditions to honor Our Lord for the Feast of the Epiphany. Remember, if you feel the little gold crown (or a "baby Jesus") in your mouth after biting into your slice of cake, don't try to swallow it! Did You Know? How to receive Holy Communion:

Has it perhaps been awhile since you studied the proper manner in which to receive Holy Communion? We all need a refresher from time to time, and there is an excellent set of instructions on page 297 of My Catholic Faith. When receiving, one should hold the head level and open the mouth. The tongue should be extended so it goes slightly out over the lower lip. One should not say anything after receiving. One should also not make the Sign of the Cross after receiving, as the communicant now has He who bore the Cross of our Redemption dwelling in their very body and soul. Making the Sign of the Cross after receiving also increases the risk of knocking the Communion paten being held underneath the chin, which could cause consecrated particles to fall off.
