There were three different "King's Cakes" (it was one of my bites that contained the Infant Jesus!), as well as a reenactment of the Adoration of the Magi and a pinata. It gave much so much joy to the children and onlookers alike! Our winner of the Crèche Drawing Contest was declared before all and took his prize.

One of the former pastors of St. Margaret Mary's, <u>Father Stan Zak, passed away</u> last Sunday, January 8. May God grant rest to this faithful priest of forty-seven years. Fr. Zak's viewing and vigil will take place on Sunday, January 22 from 6 to 9 pm. His Funeral Mass (Ordinary Form) will be offered on Monday, January 23 at 10 am. All services will be held at St. Margaret Mary's.

Please pray for the <u>repose of the soul of Cardinal Pell</u>, who died this past Tuesday, January 10. Cardinal Pell, unjustly accused and then imprisoned, and finally freed on recognition of his innocence, served the Church for many years as a true and faithful son, and a brave defender of the Church's perennial teachings. Eternal rest, grant unto him, O Lord. Requiescat in pace.

From this <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 18 to Wednesday</u>, <u>January 25</u>, at Holy Mass, the prayer titled *Pro Ecclesiæ unitate* (called in some missals *ad tollendum schisma*) will replace the prayer for the Sovereign Pontiff. This prayer is offered for the return of Holy Mother Church's separated brethren, notably the Protestants, to the One, True Sheepfold of Christ: the Catholic Church.

Our monthly <u>Sursum Corda event for young adult</u> Catholics will take place this <u>Thursday</u>, <u>January 19</u>. The evening will begin at 6 pm with the Rosary recited in church, followed by a talk at 6:30, a social dinner at 7, and the chanted Office of Compline to conclude the evening. #### Did You Know? The Use of Beeswax Candles:

Have you ever wondered why the tradition developed in Holy Mother Church of using beeswax candles on the altar? The Catholic Encyclopedia (1907) gives us this insight on the mystical symbolism thereof:

"For mystical reasons the Church prescribes that the candles used at Mass and at other liturgical functions be made of beeswax (luminaria cerea. — Missale Rom., De Defectibus, X, I; Cong. Sac. Rites, 4 September, 1875). The pure wax extracted by bees from flowers symbolizes the pure flesh of Christ received from His Virgin Mother, the wick signifies the soul of Christ, and the flame represents His divinity. Although the two latter properties are found in all kinds of candles, the first is proper of beeswax candles only."

The annual Walk for Life West Coast will take place next Saturday, January 21 in San Francisco, as usual. The event will begin at 11 am. As always, the Oakland and San Jose apostolates of the Institute of Christ the King will take part in this important occasion of witness to the sanctity of human life. We hope to see you there!
