Dear Parishioners,

We are very thankful for your donations and financial support of Most Precious Blood of Jesus Parish. Included in the Parish Financial Summary for the twelve-month period ending 6/30/2022 are the following Capital Projects (valued at greater than \$4,000 each):

- Completion of three Church restrooms
- Restoration of the Baptistery
- Continued Church electrical work
- Church concrete work
- Priory window replacements
- Priory restoration and remodeling

In addition to the above capital improvements, it is noteworthy to mention that the Parish employs a full-time Facilities Superintendent, responsible for <u>Maintenance and Repair</u> of all buildings, heating systems, electrical systems, plumbing systems, superstructure, interior surfaces, exterior surfaces, windows, doors, security systems, restrooms, roof systems, generally anything and everything mechanical, on a campus-wide basis. Needless to say, Maintenance and Repair (\$295,508 last year alone) is our #1 annual expenditure and will be for the foreseeable future.

As a reminder, our Church structure (St. Francis Xavier) was built in 1927. And while we are blessed to offer Holy Mass, the size and age of the Church require constant attention. I am often asked, "Canon Avis, how can we help with our donations, where can our donations be put to best use?" Now you know the easy answer. Please know that your donations primarily go toward Glorifying Our Blessed Lord by maintaining His House and Glorifying Him at Mass. In so doing, I ask you to be a generous as you can since maintenance & repair remains to be an uphill challenge.

BY THE NUMBERS

The total number of registered families in the Parish has grown to 559 compared to the total registered the previous year of 495, a growth of almost 13%. However, of those 559 families, 28% are not receiving parish tax credit for any of their weekly donations since they do not use offertory envelopes. It is strongly encouraged to utilize MPBOJ parish offertory envelopes or MPBOJ Faith Direct online so that the Parish can record your donations for tax credit.

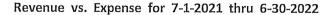

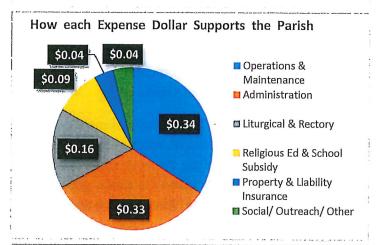
