THE UNITY & TRINITY OF GOD **THE UNITY & TRINITY OF C** Lesson 3 from the Baltimore Catechism (con't)

29. What do we mean by the Blessed Trinity? By the Blessed Trinity we mean, one and the same God in three Divine Persons.

34. What is a supernatural mystery?

A supernatural mystery is a truth which we cannot fully understand, but which we firmly believe because we have God's word for it.
