Requiescat in Pace

Pope Benedict XVI, baptized Joseph Alois Ratzinger, (April 16, 1927, Marktl am Inn, Germany—December 31, 2022, Vatican City), bishop of Rome and head of the Roman Catholic Church (2005–13).

Prior to his election as pope, Cardinal Ratzinger had a distinguished role in the Universal Church as a theologian and as Prefect of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith. He elevated the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest to an Institute of Pontifical Right on October 8, 2008.

When Does the Christmas Season End?

The Christmas Season ends with Candlemas, the Feast of the Forty Days. The Church has traditionally celebrated the Christmas season for forty days, from Christmas Day to February 2, which is the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also called Candlemas.

There is a Fourth-Century A.D. eyewitness account of the Feast of the Forty Days by a pilgrim named Egeria. In the beginning of the Christian era, Christ’s birth was celebrated, along with the Epiphany, on January 6, so Egeria wrote of a procession and Mass in Jerusalem on the fortieth day after Epiphany. When Christmas was later moved to December 25, the date of the Feast of the Forty Days was moved back also, to February 2.

Some time before the Eighth Century, February 2 also began to be celebrated as the Marian Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

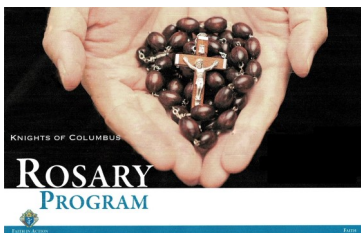
