And Jesus hearing this marvelled, and said to them that followed Him: Amen I say to you, I have not found so great faith in Israel. And I say to you, that many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven: but the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into the exterior darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. And Jesus said to the centurion: Go, and as thou hast believed, so be it done to thee. And the servant was healed at the same hour.



Candlemas, Thursday, February 2

Also known as the Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord Jesus Christ, as well as the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Candlemas commemorates the events related in the account of the presentation of Jesus in the Temple recounted in Luke Ch. II, which took place in accordance with Exodus 13. And according to Leviticus 12, a woman was to be purified by presenting a lamb for a burnt offering, and either a young pigeon or dove as sin offering to the priests, thirty-three days after a son's circumcision. It falls on February 2, which is the 40th day after the nativity and the conclusion of the Christmas season.


