### First Sunday of Lent



At that time, Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert, to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterwards He was hungry. And the tempter coming said to Him: If Thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread. Who answered and said: It is written: Not in bread alone doth man live, but in every word that proceedeth from the mouth of God. Then the devil took Him up into the holy city and set Him upon the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him: If Thou be the Son of God, cast Thyself down. For it is written: That He hath given His angels charge over Thee, and in their hands shall they bear Thee up, lest perhaps Thou dash Thy foot against a stone. ### Little Lesson on Church Music

For three Sundays the choir has sung a psalm during the procession just before the beginning of Mass, using a psalm tone from one of the eight modes. Today the choir will sing, after the gradual, the tract on a psalm tone, although it has its own proper melody which takes longer to sing. This kind of chanting, which is easily learned, is found in the verse of the Asperges, of the Introit, and in the verses at Communion.

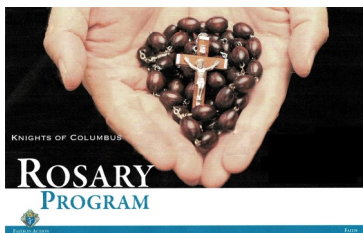
