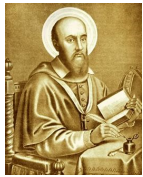

The Transfiguration of Our Lord Jesus Christ

Take advantage of a perfect opportunity to invite your family and friends and share a pleasant time together in honor of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

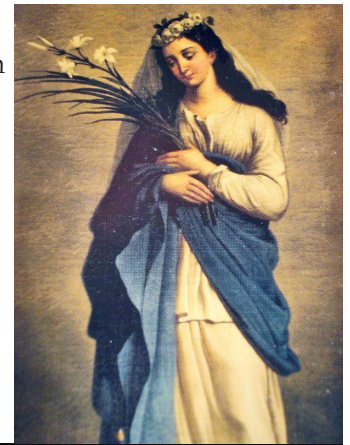
At camp last week, each team built an altar and prayed at it. May God continue to guide our sons so that they learn to offer worthy sacrifices in His Honor.

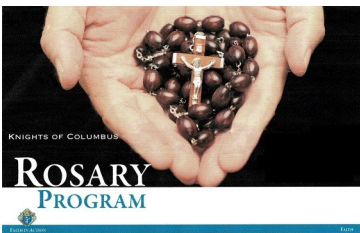
