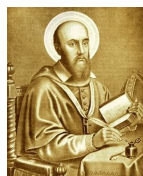

At that time, Jesus spoke this parable to the multitudes: **The kingdom of heaven is likened to a man that sowed good seed in his field. 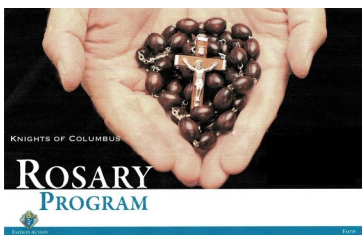
