The Third Sunday After Epiphany

At that time, when Jesus was come down from the mountain, great multitudes followed Him: and behold a leper came and adored Him, saying: Lord, if Thou wilt, Thou canst make me clean. And Jesus stretching forth His hand, touched him, saying: I will. Be thou made clean. And forthwith his leprosy was cleansed. And Jesus saith to him: See thou tell no man: but go, show thyself to the priest, and offer the gift which Moses commanded for a testimony unto them. And when

he had entered into Capharnaum, there came to him a centurion, beseeching Him, and saying: Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, and is grievously tormented. And Jesus saith to him: I will come and heal him. And the centurion making answer, said: Lord, I am not worthy that Thou shouldst enter under my roof: but only say the word, and my servant shall be healed. For I also am a man subject to authority, having under me soldiers; and I say to this: Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant: Do this, and he doeth it. And Jesus hearing this, marvelled, and said to them that followed Him: Amen I say to you, I have not found so great faith in Isreal. And I say to you that many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven: but the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into the exterior darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. And Jesus said to the centurion: Go, and as thou has believed, so be it done to thee. And the servant was healed at the same hour.

February 2 at 6:30pm
at the IHM Oratory
Chapel**

Also known as the Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord Jesus Christ, as well as the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Candlemas commemorates the events related in

the account of the presentation of Jesus in the Temple recounted in Luke Ch. 2, which took place in accordance with Exodus Ch. 13. According to Leviticus Ch. 12, a woman was to be purified by presenting a lamb for a burnt offering, and either a young pigeon or dove as sin offering to the priests, thirty-three days after a son's circumcision. It falls on February 2, which is the 40th day after the nativity and is the conclusion of the Christmas season.

Please note: There is no low mass at noon.

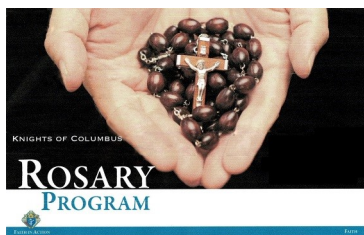
