



Each Sunday of Lent, the choir will sing a verse of Psalm 50, Miserere mei Deus, during communion. For the 2nd Sunday of Lent:


Make me a clean heart, O God: and renew a right spirit within me.


ADULT CATECHISM "LEGALISM" March 20th, 4:30pm




Benevolent Society
