Today's High Mass features the cumulative work of the oratory's academic programs for the Spring '22 semester. Since January, the Chant Class has been studying 'Missa Lux et origo', the Gregorian Mass Ordinary designated to Paschaltide, as well as the Mass Proper chants for the 4th Sunday after Easter. The students of the Private Studio have studied and prepared over a dozen Catholic motets by Medieval, Renaissance, Baroque, and Romantic composers. Today's polyphonic features include 'Virgo Dei Trono Digna', a medieval motet, and a Baroque setting of the 'O Sacrum Convivium' by Giovanni Battista Pergolesi. These endeavors are in tandem with the oratory's Preparatory Choirs and the Private Piano Studio in developing a holistic music academy at St. Francis de Sales. 
