Note about Today's Music

Today's Mass in honor of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ features music by Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847), including "Bone Pastor" a movement from his choral setting of "Lauda Sion" ("Praise Zion"), the sequence written by St. Thomas Aquinas for the Feast of Corpus Christi. By composing this piece in 1846 for a Belgian church's 600th anniversary, Mendelssohn adorns Aquinas' interpretation of the term "Zion" to represent the Blessed Sacrament. This is significant because Mendelssohn, a convert to Christianty, did so at a time when the meaning of "Zion" was becoming contested in Europe. His conversion and service to the Eucharistic Zion, while drawing criticism from peers, remains a testament to the efficacious power of the Real Presence on all souls in all times and in all places.


