##### Note about Today's Music

Today's Mass in honor of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ features music by Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847), including "Bone Pastor" a movement from his choral setting of "Lauda Sion" ("Praise Zion"), the sequence written by St. Thomas Aquinas for the Feast of Corpus Christi. By composing this piece in 1846 for a Belgian church's 600th anniversary, Mendelssohn adorns Aquinas' interpretation of the term "Zion" to represent the Blessed Sacrament. This is significant because Mendelssohn, a convert to Christianity, did so at a time when the meaning of "Zion" was becoming contested in Europe. His conversion and service to the Eucharistic Zion, while drawing criticism from peers, remains a testament to the efficacious power of the Real Presence on all souls in all times and in all places.

computer skills, and deep devotion to the Eucharist. He was beatified on 10 Oct. 2020.

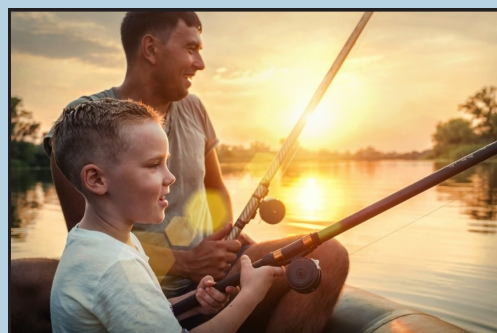

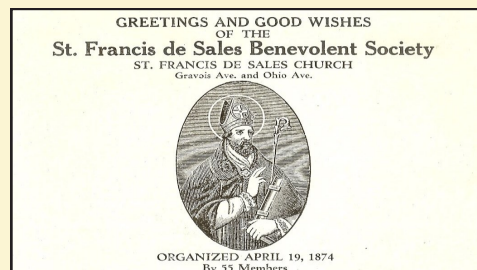

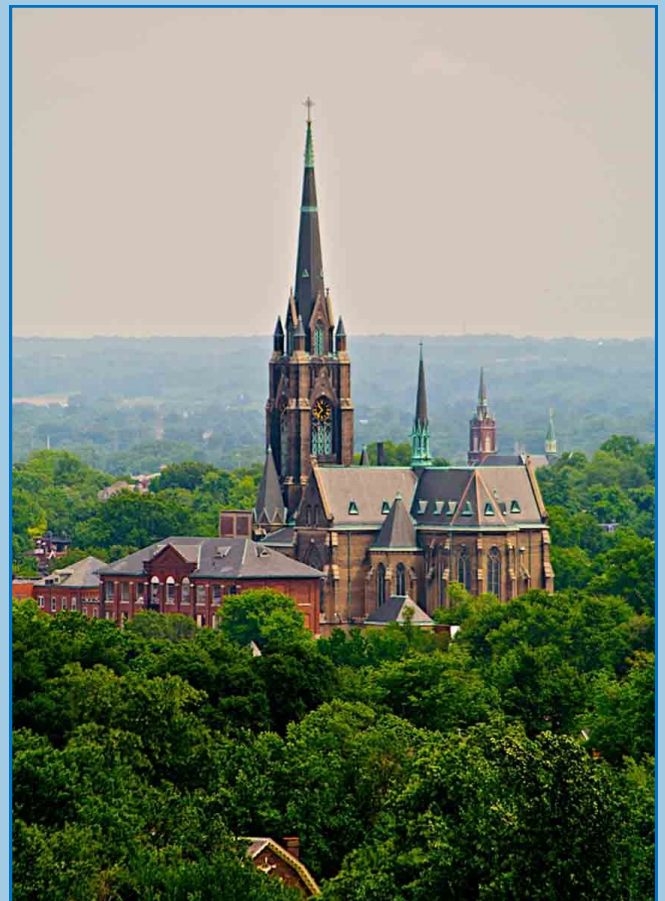
