NEWS AND UPCOMING EVENTS

Dear Oratory Members,

As July 1, 2022 starts the new fiscal year for the Oratory, it seems appropriate to provide a general overview of our financial position to you.

We finished the year having collected \$643,384.50 which is \$139,384.50 over our goal of \$504,000.00. The \$504,000.00 goal represents the yearly operating costs for the Oratory. This includes insurance, salaries, utilities and upkeep mainly. This does not include extra renovations to the Church or Oratory property.

Because of your generosity and devotion to our mission in St. Louis this past fiscal year, we have been able to use the surplus funds to help with several major renovation projects on the property. In the Fall of 2022 we installed a new LVT floor in the Church basement, making that space much more agreeable to use. Additionally, we have been able to professionally sandblast and paint the iron fencing around the Oratory property, Install new led lighting on the church tower, repair the copper roof gutters of the South Sacristy, tuck point the South exterior staircase and elevator entrance as well as tuck point the upper south wall of the gymnasium. These projects would not have been possible without your generosity!

Currently, we have a plan to upgrade and restore the bathrooms in the gymnasium so that this building can once again be used both for the homeschooling coop and other Oratory events. Additionally, the roof over the iconic St. Francis de Sales School portico on the 1888 building will be soon replaced to halt the infiltration of water into the space just below.

Admittedly, there are still many things to improve on both the property and in the church building. However, with your continued sacrifices, we will be able to complete important restoration projects one at a time.

In human terms this is a daunting prospect. However, with Faith and Grace, even the most impossible things become possible!


CONFIRMATION CLASS BEGINS
