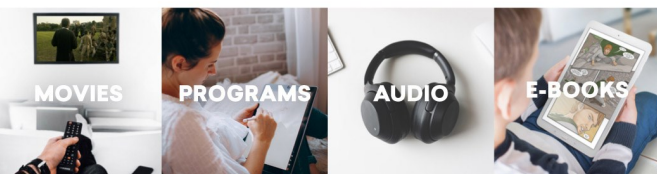
## PRACTICE FOR NEW ALTAR BOYS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 11
