

ADVENT EMBER DAYS

The Advent Ember Days take place on Wednesday, December 14, Friday, December 16th and Saturday, December 17th these days are traditionally days of fasting and abstinence. Though the current Code of Canon Law does not demand that we fast, we are still encouraged to do so. Monsignor Wach has repeatedly encouraged the Institute canons and oblates to fast for the benefit of Holy Mother Church in these trying times. Therefore, members of the faithful wishing to join the St. Francis de Sales Oratory cleric community in fasting (2 small snacks and 1 meatless meal) these three days, may sign up at the appointed table in the Oratory basement after both the 8am and 10:30am Masses TODAY. The Oratory community will say their rosary for your intentions these days as well.

NEED A NANNY TO ASSIST YOU WITH YOUR CHILDREN


Contact the office if you are interested in hiring a nanny. They are CPR certified. The cost will be around \$15-\$30 per hour. Traditional Catholics.
