





PLENARY INDULGENCES

The Institute of Christ the King recognizes the importance of a deep harmony between faith, liturgy, life, and the power of beauty in attracting the human senses to the things above, an integral part of the Institute's charism is the calibration of the liturgy according to the usus antiquior of the Roman Rite, with the liturgical books of 1962 being normative. Great care for a solemn liturgy, complete fidelity to the doctrine of the Church and the Holy Father, and awareness of the central role of Grace, especially Charity - these are essential elements of the Institute's spirituality, which is drawn from its three co-patrons, St. Benedict, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Francis de Sales. March is the month that two of our principal co-patrons have feast days. The Feast of St. Thomas Aquinas is on Monday, March 7 and the Feast of St. Benedict is on Monday, March 21. Please remember the Institute in prayer, especially on these days. A Plenary Indulgence may be obtained by the faithful who assist at Mass at an Institute church or chapel on this feast day (the usual conditions apply.)

NOTE FROM MUSIC DIRECTOR FOR THE FIRST SUNDAY OF QUDRAGESIMA

Next time you are at the communion rail you may observe the following words from Psalm 90, found on the sanctuary floor:

Super aspidem et basilicum ambulabis, et conculcabis leonem et draconem.

TRANSLATION:

Upon the asp and basilisk shalt thou tread, and thou shalt trample upon the lion and dragon.

Today, for the first Sunday of Quadragesima, the schola will sing these words as they appear in the ninth verse of the *tract*, the chant which immediately precedes the Gospel. This tract is only sung once a year, the First Sunday of Lent. Praise God for such a profound confluence of architecture and of music for the edification of the faithful!


