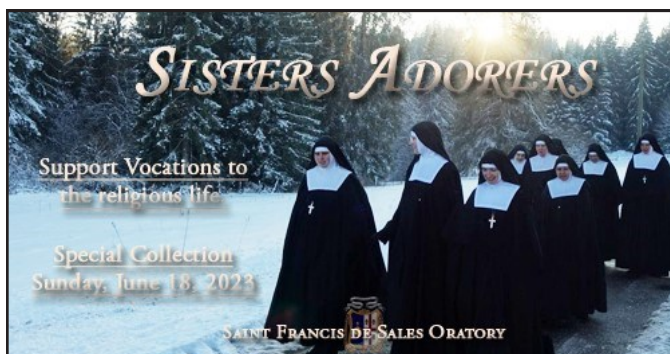

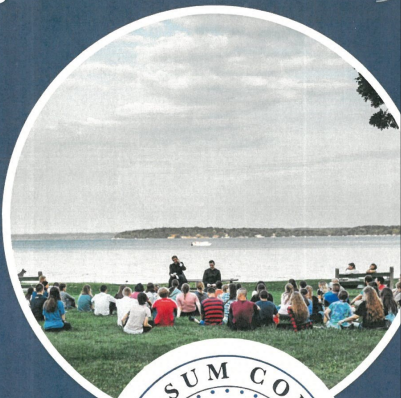

KEEPING GOD'S CHURCH BEAUTIFUL

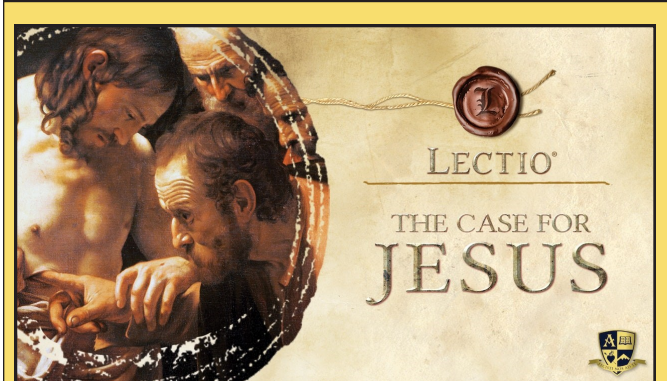

THE CASE FOR JESUS WITH DR. BRANT PITRE

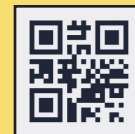
Do you follow Jesus ‘on the way’?
