

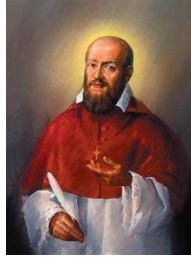

**Confirmation will be Monday, May 22 at 6PM.** A reception will follow at the Fr. Vecchio Hall of Our Lady of Prompt Succor.

**Pentecost Novena:** On the Saturday after the Ascension, we will begin the Pentecost Novena to the Holy Ghost. The novena in honor of the Holy Ghost is the oldest of all novenas since it was first made at the direction of Our Lord Himself when He sent His Apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Ghost on the first Pentecost. Addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light and strength and love so sorely needed by every Catholic today. We will send out Flocknote reminders each day.

**May is the Month of Mary!** We will do a perpetual rosary during the month of May. We're looking for 60 volunteers to help. **Vespers Continues:** There will be no Vespers this Sunday.

**Hurricane Season:** Thursday June 1 marks the beginning of Hurricane. On this day, Bishop Provost will celebrate mass at 4PM at St. Mary of the Lake in Big Lake and then make a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Our Lady Star of the Sea in Cameron at 5:30PM. Our oratory will organize a pilgrimage at a later date.

- Thursday, June 8: Benediction at 6 and class with Canon immediately follows
- Saturday June 10: Meat at church for 11:30AM for rehearsal
- Sunday June 11: High Mass with procession and First Holy communion at 10:30AM

  - Girls wear white dress, white shoes, white veil
