Tenth Sunday after Pentecost

INTROIT: *Ps. 54: 17,18,20,23,2* When I cried to the Lord He heard my voice, from them that draw near to me; and He humbled them, Who is before all ages, and remains for ever: cast thy care upon the Lord, and He shall sustain thee. (Ps) Hear, O God, my prayer, and despise not my supplication; be attentive to me and hear me. Glory be. When I cried to the Lord...

COLLECT : O God, Who dost manifest Thine almighty power most chiefly in sparing and showing mercy: multiply upon us Thy mercy: that as we hasten towards Thy promises, Thou mayest make us partakers of heavenly treasures. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE: *I Cor. 12: 2-11* Brethren, you know that, when you were heathens, you went to dumb idols, according as you were led. Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man, speaking by the Spirit of God, saith Anathema to Jesus; and no man can say: The Lord Jesus, but by the Holy Ghost. Now there are diversities of graces, but the same Spirit; and there are diversities of ministries, but the same Lord; and there are diversities of operations, but the same God, Who worketh all in all. And the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man unto profit. To one indeed, by the Spirit, is given the word of wisdom; and to another, the word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit; to another the grace of healing in one Spirit; to another, the working of miracles; to another, prophecy; to another, the discerning of spirits; to another, divers kinds of tongues; to another, interpretation of speeches. But all these things one and the same Spirit worketh, dividing to every one according as He will.

GRADUAL: *Ps. 16: 8, 2* Keep me, O Lord, as the apple of Thine eye: protect me under the shadow of Thy wings. Let my judgement come forth from Thy countenance:: let Thine eyes behold the thing that is equitable.

ALLELUIA: *Ps. 64: 2* Alleluia, alleluia. A hymn, O God, becometh thee in Sion: and a vow shall be paid to Thee in Jerusalem. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: *Lk. 18: 9-14* At that time, Jesus spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves as just, and despised others. Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one was a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee standing, prayed thus with himself: O God, I give Thee thanks that I am not as the rest of men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers; as also is this publican. I fast twice in the week; I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican standing afar off would not so much as lift up his eyes towards heaven, but struck his breast saying: O God, be merciful to me a sinner. I say to you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: because every one that exalteth himself shall be humbled, and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

OFFERTORY: *Ps. 24: 1-3* To Thee, O Lord, have I lifted up my soul: in Thee, O my God, I put my trust, let me not be ashamed: neither let mine enemies laugh at me: for none of them that wait on Thee shall be confounded.

SECRET: Let the appointed sacrifice be offered to Thee, O Lord: which Thou hast arranged to be offered to the honor of Thy name in such wise that it may be a remedy to us. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION: *Ps. 50: 51, 21* Thou wilt accept the sacrifice of justice, oblations, and holocausts, upon Thine altar, O Lord.

POSTCOMMUNION: We beseech Thee, O Lord, our God, that in Thy goodness Thou wilt not deprive of Thine aid those whom Thou dost not cease to renew with Thy divine Sacraments. Through our Lord.



Assumption of Our Lady

INTROIT: *Apocalypse 12: 1* A great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. *Ps. 97: 1* Sing ye to the Lord a new canticle: because He hath done wonderful things. Glory be... A great sign...

COLLECT: Almighty and everlasting God, who hast taken up the Immaculate Virgin Mary, the Mother of Thy Son, with body and soul into heavenly glory: grant, we beseech Thee, that we may always, intent on higher things, deserve to be partakers of her glory. Through the same our Lord...

EPISTLE: *Judith 13: 22-25; 15: 10* The Lord hath blessed thee by his power, because by thee he hath brought our enemies to naught. Blessed art thou O daughter, by the Lord the most high God, above all women upon the earth. Blessed be the Lord who made heaven and earth who hath directed thee to the cutting off the head of the prince of our enemies because he hath so magnified thy name this day, that thy praise shall not depart out of the mouth of men who shall be mindful of the power of the Lord forever; for that thou hast not spared thy life, by reason of the distress and tribulation of thy people, but hast prevented our ruin in the presence of our God. Thou art the glory of Jerusalem thou art the joy of Israel, thou art the honor of our people.

GRADUAL: *Ps. 44: 11-12 & 14* Hearken, O daughter, and see, and incline thy ear: and the King shall greatly desire thy beauty. *V.* The daughter of the King comes in, all beautiful: her robes are of golden cloth.

ALLELUIA: Alleluia, alleluia. Mary has been taken up into heaven: the choirs of angels rejoice. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: *Lk. 1: 41-50* At that time: Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and cried out with a loud voice saying: Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb! And how have I deserved that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For behold, the

moment that the sound of thy greeting came to my ears, the babe in my womb leapt for joy. And blessed is she who has believed, because the things promised her by the Lord shall be accomplished. And Mary said: My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my saviour; because he has regarded the lowliness of his handmaid; for, behold, henceforth all generations shall call me blessed; because he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name; and his mercy is from generation unto generation on those who fear him.

OFFERTORY: *Genesis 3: 15* I will put enmities between thee and the Woman, and between thy seed and her Seed.

SECRET: May the offering of our devotion ascend to Thee, O Lord; and through the intercession of the most blessed Virgin Mary, who was taken up into heaven, may our hearts be inflamed with the fire of love, and continually long for Thee. Through our Lord...

PREFACE: It is truly meet and just, right and availing unto salvation, that we should at all times and in all places give thanks unto Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty and everlasting God; and magnify Thee with due praise, bless and proclaim Thee in the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary; we should praise, bless and proclaim Thee. For she conceived Thine only-begotten Son by the overshadowing of the Holy Ghost, and losing not the glory of her virginity, gave forth to the world the everlasting Light, Jesus Christ our Lord, Through whom the angels praise Thy majesty, the dominions worship it, and the powers stand in awe. The Heavens and the heavenly hosts with the blessed seraphim join together in celebrating their joy. With these we pray Thee join our voices also, while we say with lowly praise: Holy, Holy, Holy...

COMMUNION: *Luke 1: 48-49* All generations shall call me blessed, because He that is mighty hath done great things to me.

POSTCOMMUNION: Now that we have received, O Lord, the Sacrament of salvation, grant, we beseech Thee, that through the merits and the intercession of the blessed Virgin Mary, who was taken up into heaven, we may be brought to the glory of the resurrection. Through our Lord...
